

Required documents for student visa

Please check the circles if completed:

- F-1 for ESL Language programs
- M-1 Visas for careers only
- Copy of High school Diploma or college Diploma
- Copy of student passport
- Support economic documents such as:
- A_ Attestation support letter where shows who will be responsible to cover all student living and school tuition while student is in the USA. (Must be notarized)
- B_ Bank letter showing that the sponsor or students has enough funds to cover all the living and school expenses.
 - For ESL students \$ 20,000 or more
 - For M-1 Visas \$ 27,000 or more

Admission application form:

- I-20 Request form
- Admission application form
- \$150 registration fee payable to the school is (non-refundable)
- \$350 fee payable online to SEVIS paid by credit card (non-refundable)
- \$ 85 for fingerprints now required by Homeland Security. (only for students in USA doing Change of status.)
- Change of status requires two money orders of \$370 each, one for change of status, another one for extension of status at the same time. We must do two applications in order to apply for change of status to student visa.
- \$150 shipping fee, if student is applying from overseas.
- Every student must pay 10% of school tuition along with the registration.

Once we have all these documents, we will be able to get the I-20 formulary and acceptance letter from the school, so student will be able to make the Visa appointment at the US Consulate in their Country.

NOTE : If Visa is not granted at US Consulate overseas, CTI will refund back the 10% paid by the student.
