The following information is reported under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. This report is effective **June 30, 2021**, and is updated from **June 30, 2021**.

- (1) This statement shall serve to acknowledge that our institution signed and returned a Certification and Agreement and provides the assurance that the institution has used or will use the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- (2) The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is \$258,680.
- (3) The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs as of the date of this is \$258,688.43.
- (4) The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is 301.
- (5) The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is 301.

All residential (physically attending the campus) and online students who were actively as of March 2021 are eligible under The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II.

The institution will issue a round of Emergency Student Grants to all eligible actively enrolled students as of the March date. Students have the option to apply these funds to their school outstanding balance or use them as a financial aid for expenses related to the disruption due to coronavirus, such as food housing course materials, technology health care and childcare expenses.

Students who are eligible for Financial Aid and decide to apply the funds, a copy of the student account ledger will be provided as a reference. Business Office will provide an explanation per student basis.
