

Required documents for I-20

- Completed Student Enrollment Application Documents.
- Completed I-20 Application.
- Career Technical Institute application fee of \$150.
- Proof of English ability through Wonderlic Assessment.
- Proof of a high school diploma or its equivalent notarized/legalized.
- Proof of financial support through notarized affidavit and/or notarized bank letter showing amount of \$29,000 for first year's tuition and estimated living expenses. If traveling with spouse an additional \$5,000 and \$4,500 for each dependent. Expenses are estimated and may be more or less than the amount stated.
- Copy of your Passport that is valid for at least six months after the desired start date.
- Additional documents may be requested as needed.
- 10% tuition deposit (Will be credited towards entire tuition and fees. Refundable only if visa is denied at Consulate or admission is denied.)
- \$150 Shipping fee for students residing outside the US for I-20 and student acceptance letter if required.

Upon I-20 issuance:
